I can make an educated guess that I hold more paper for my walls then do you.

Richard Keyt corrected the grammar and spelling. The following shows the changes Richard recommended:

I also have and Ph.HD. degree from Berkeley. I was a document preparer person for 20 plus years, and I have done well-created over 5,000 corporations and, HeLLCs. etc., and I have also prepared over 15,000 family law forms over the years, and fFor you to placestate on your URLwebsite that document preparers people are not educated properly is not true. I can make an educated guess that I haveold more paper onfor my walls thean do-you.

The following is a clean version of the edited email message:

I am an attorney from California who was a paralegal with an M.S. degree in paralegal studies. I now have a J.D. degree and an M.S. degree in legal studies from UCLA. I also have a Ph.D. degree from Berkeley. I was a document preparer for 20 plus years. I have created over 5,000 corporations and LLCs. I have also prepared over 15,000 family law forms over the years. For you to state on your website that document preparers are not educated properly is not true. I have more paper on my walls than you.

Here are my comments to the writer of the email message:

GRADE: F- Please rewrite. Do not use run on sentences. Do not capitalize words that should not be capitalized. Your education is not clear. Do you have two M.S. degrees, one in paralegal studies and another in legal studies? Do you then have three law related degrees from UCLA? According to the UCLA website (see the list of UCLA graduate programs on the next page), it does not offer graduate degrees in either paralegal studies or legal studies. Are you sure you got your M.S. degrees from UCLA? In what area did you get your Ph.D. degree? Clearly it was not English or writing. Also, I searched the California State Bar's website to see if you are licensed to practice law in California and got the message "Your search for xxxxx x. xxxxx returned no results." Are you practicing law in California without a license or are you licensed in another state? If you are licensed in another state, which state?

The point I try to make on my website about document preparers is that nobody should ever trust another person to prepare legal documents for them unless they know the background and experience of that person. My background and experience is clearly stated on my website, but few document preparers give the public any information about their background and experience in forming entities.

What is your point about wall paper? Do you mean certificates that evidence graduation from a formal class of study? Are you challenging me to a diploma duel? I have a lot of diplomas (graduation certificates) from formal courses of study. Here are a few courses from which I graduated in the six years I was in the United States Air Force: officer training school (3 months), flight school (1 year), basic survival school (2 weeks), water survival school (2 weeks), M-16 expert marksman; F-4 Phantom supersonic jet fighter training (6 months), jungle survival school (2 weeks), nuclear alert certified; and F-4 instructor school. I was an F-4 instructor for three years and taught people how to fly the F-4 in the class room (aircraft general, weapons release computer system and combat mission planning), in the simulator and in the air.
