26 Having considered the stipulation of the parties for entry of a Preliminary Injunction
and good cause appearing:

A PRELIMINARY INUNCTION IS ORDERED as follows:

Defendants, their officer, agents, representative, servants, employees, attorneys and/or
those persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Order
by personal service or otherwise are hereby enjoined and restrained from directly or indirectly:


- (a) That defendants shall not enter the Madison Property, without advance notice to Plaintiff as required by Section 32 of the Lease.
- (b) That defendants shall not enter the Madison property unless they are accompanied by an agent of plaintiff who is also a licensed medical marijuana

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dispensary agent.

- (c) That defendants shall not be allowed to tamper with the security system or video camera system operated by plaintiff at the Madison Property.
- (d) That defendants shall not be allowed to tamper with or interfere with, in any fashion, the marijuana plants or crop grown or located at the Madison Property.
- (e) This injunction is not intended to alter or further restrict the right of reasonable, escorted access to inspect the property as authorized in the Court's March 17, 2014 order in Case Number CV2014-003047.
